

2 LITRE SPORTS SEDAN VICTORIAN SERIES IDENTIFICATION REGULATIONS

This document is a detailed supplement to section 4 **Signage** of the **2 Litre Sports Sedan Victorian Series 2009 Sporting Regulations**, to be eligible for championship points in this Series, competing vehicles must carry the following signage. The referred to 'Schedule K' can be found in the CAMS manual of motor sport.

- A)** – The 2 litre SS series identification decals to be displayed in the area directly above the competition number as shown in Figure K-1 of Schedule K. If there is insufficient space available above the competition number then the sticker may be placed below the competition number.
- B)** – The competition number as described in article 2.2 & 2.3 of Schedule K and shown in Figure K-1
- C)** – The “Dayglo” yellow windscreen competition number as described in article 2.3 of Schedule K and shown in Figure K-3
- D)** – The provisions must be made for a blank 138mm white circle pitstop decal directly below the windscreen competition number. These decals will be issued at the appropriate rounds. These decals **MUST BE REMOVED** for non-pitstop (CPS) races.
- E)** – The small club website sticker is to be displayed across the lower edge of the windscreen on the same side as the windscreen competition number.
- F)** – An area 200mm high across the top of the windscreen must be made available for the Series or Round sponsor signage, as described in article 7.2.2 of Schedule K. The Series signage will be issued at Round 1 and must be displayed in this location throughout the year. Or Round signage will be issued at each round and must be displayed in this location throughout that round.
- G)** – An area on the rear of the car either on the boot edge, bumper or between the taillights must be made available for additional Series or Round sponsor signage. The Series signage will be issued at Round 1 and must be displayed in this location throughout the year. Or Round signage will be issued at each round and must be displayed in this location throughout that round.
- H)** – The drivers name must be displayed on the lower edge of the rearmost side window, as described in article 3 of Schedule K.
- I)** – An area on each side of the vehicle near the front must be made available for additional Series or Round sponsor signage. The Series signage will be issued at Round 1 and must be displayed in this location throughout the year. Or Round signage will be issued at each round and must be displayed in this location throughout that round.

Shown below is the area location on a RH drive vehicle that matches with the above points.
